TOKYO SKYTREE is located on the lev line (a straight alignment passing through ancient sites and sacred places) that connects Mt. Fuji, Meiji Shrine, the Imperial Palace (formerly the Edo Castle), and Kashima jingu grand shrine in Kashima, Ibaraki Prefecture. This makes the tower known as a spot where positive energy comes in. Ribbons filled with wishes from our guests will be enshrined in Kashima Jingu Grand Shrine positioned as the starting point of the ley line.




